# LyLena Estabine AB'24

Since when has the key to your heart been your intellect?" This is the answer God gave to LyLena Estabine one evening during Adoration. "I'm rarely satisfied not knowing things," explains Estabine, a Harvard College Senior and recent convert to the Catholic faith.

Estabine, originally from Olathe, Kansas, was raised in a protestant family and has always been involved in her faith, but found herself starting to consider aspects of Catholic teaching. Two of her blockmates, Tresor Nshimiye AB'24 and Alex Dyer AB'24, were already active members of the Harvard Catholic community, and encouraged Estabine to examine her faith more deeply. "All friend groups, they stay up late and have deep conversations," said Estabine; just in her case, they were staying up late to discuss theology

Like many converts, Estabine had to wrestle with some big questions: "I was navigating this idea of objective truth and if there is such a thing, if something is objectively true it doesn't matter if you believe in it or not. It's either true or it's not."

Throughout the following summer Estabine continued to contemplate various aspects of Catholic theology and her relationship with the Lord. She recalled one night while she was in Paris where she opened her Bible to John 10:16, and realized "I knew where God was calling me and I was using intellectual rationale to stave it off" and that "I don't know everything and should explore this with a little bit more humility."

genres in high school, but in recent years, she explains, she has felt "called to enter into a more purposeful music expression, a music expression for His kingdom."

Estabine has been recording and producing Christian music throughout her time at Harvard, and was recently invited to perform two original works during the inauguration events for Harvard President Claudine Gay.

In the following months Estabine continued to discuss her questions with friends and with Fr. Patrick Fiorillo, and then enrolled in RCIA at St. Paul's, eventually entering the Church at the Easter Vigil in 2023 with Nshimiye as her sponsor.

Estabine is also an accomplished singer, songwriter, poet, and author. She calls songwriting "her first artform," and has been writing praise and worship songs since she was a small child. She briefly explored other

As she approaches the end of her graduation this coming May, Estabine offers some advice to future generations of Harvard Catholics. "It's not about where you are going, it is about who you will be when you get there. Especially at a place like Harvard it can be easy to brute force your way to where you think you are supposed to be. Allow and appreciate the beauty of the imperfect journey home." ■

# Samuel DeMerit AM'53

**A**nyone who has attended the 12:10 PM Mass at St. Paul's or stopped by Coffee Hour after Mass will recognize Samuel DeMerit, who is a constant in the pews of St. Paul's.

Born and raised in a small city in Wisconsin, DeMerit was raised Protestant, attending Sunday School (but not services), first at Methodist Church and then later at a Congregational Church across town. During his youth he developed a love of music and was given a robust music education in his public school and the opportunity to sing in choirs.

This is when DeMerit also found his fascination for languages, which would later bring him to Harvard. In high school he opted to study the German language, but with the outbreak of World War II came the cessation of the German program, so DeMerit took Latin instead and fell in love with the language.

Following high school graduation, DeMerit enlisted in the Navy and joined the V-12 Officer Training Program, which sent young men to colleges and universities. DeMerit was sent to St. Ambrose College in Iowa, founded by the Viatorians, with many classes taught by priests. This experience started to make him sympathetic towards Roman Catholicism. Once the war was over, DeMerit went to the University of Wisconsin and completed a degree in classical languages and literature, and it is there that a professor suggested he apply to graduate school at Harvard.

Arriving in Cambridge in 1949, DeMerit met two other young men in his rooming house: Bill Donaher and James Bonnen. Combining his love of music and interest in languages, DeMerit had developed an interest in Gregorian chant. "I told Bill Donaher

that I loved Gregorian Chant, I loved the sound of it, and he said 'Sam! Come to Mass with me at St. Paul's, they have a wonderful Gregorian Choir'" recalls DeMerit.

In 1952 the Easter Vigil returned to the evening after centuries of having been celebrated in the morning, which captivated DeMerit. "I was much impressed by it," he explained. "There was a series of 12 prophecies. Now in the modern liturgy they're down to three or four, but there were 12 detailing the whole history of salvation, from Genesis to Revelation. That came as news to me. In my Protestant upbringing there had just been an emphasis on the golden rule and doing good and living a moral and exemplary life. I had not known anything about the history of salvation. That came as quite a revealing experience for me."

DeMerit spoke with Rev. Msgr. Augustine Hickey, then Harvard Catholic Chaplain and Pastor at St. Paul's, about his experience, and began instruction on the Catholic faith. Msgr. Hickey also suggested that he attend the 7 AM Missa Recitata in the lower Church, conducted

by a chorus mistress who did the responses in Latin, which DeMerit attended every day for his final year of graduate school. He was baptized conditionally into the Roman Catholic Church on Thanksgiving Day, 1952. "I remember it distinctly. James Bonnen was my sponsor," said DeMerit.

After receiving a Fulbright Grant to Germany and a career teaching in Connecticut, and Pennsylvania, and 21 years at Boston Latin, DeMerit returned to Cambridge in 1973 and has been at St. Paul's ever since. And he did eventually learn German!

Shortly after his 97th birthday, DeMerit shared a piece of advice for current and future generations of Harvard Catholics: "Attend Mass. Daily, if you can manage it. I'm very grateful I can always get to Mass, it keeps me going. It's the most important thing in my life."

DeMerit and other Coffee Hour attendees also recently assisted in identifying many of our historical photos, more of which can be found on our website. ■

## HARVARD CATHOLIC FORUM

The Harvard Catholic Forum entered its third exciting year in the Fall of 2022, with the mission and resources to sustain a vibrant, engaged Catholic intellectual community among current and future leaders here in Harvard Square.

We continued to broaden and deepen the student engagement in our community. Our twelve Undergraduate and Graduate Student Fellows, in addition to participating in many programs, offered several of their own reading groups for their peers, and one gave a full-year introductory course in Christian Latin. Our Fellows also had special opportunities to engage with our speakers and instructors at the year-end Fellows Dinner, as well as in other small groups. In both 2022 and 2023, the Forum co-sponsored weeklong summer seminars for graduate students in Cambridge on Science and Religion, enabling intense engagement across disciplines among future teachers and leaders in the academy.

Throughout the year, our lectures and classes promoted a spirit of intellectual fellowship between both participants and faculty, through informal interaction at receptions and dinners. The second semester began with three "Conversations with Catholic Scholars and Scientists," where distinguished Catholic faculty at Harvard shared their experience of Catholic academic life with thirty or so lively participants, engaging in both formal Q&A and informal conversation over food and wine.

Our programs spanned the breadth and depth of the Catholic intellectual tradition with its transcendental dimensions of Beauty, Truth, and Goodness. For example:

an inspiring address by Archbishop Bashar Warda of the Chaldean Catholic Church on building a thriving Catholic university in war-torn Iraq; two lectures on the psychological, theological, and ethical dimensions of forgiveness; a panel and afternoon seminar on the Common Good; and multiple courses in the areas of faith and reason, science and religion, and skills like New Testament Greek and Christian Latin.

Following Bishop Barron's dictum "lead with beauty," and building on the rich musical traditions of the St. Paul's community, we built our offerings in Sacred Music to a new level, with a range of programs integrating liturgy and music, history, theology, and spirituality. Through the generosity of the Considine Family Foundation, during 2022–23 the Forum developed a strategy, curriculum, and initial funding to launch a Sacred Music Division in 2024.

Our institutional growth continues with the ongoing support of the John Templeton Foundation, whose grant #62372 "In Lumine: Promoting the Catholic Intellectual Tradition on Campuses Nationwide" brings us into an invaluable community of practice with a group of centers of Catholic thought around the country. We are strengthened by the experience of our peers in what is now a national movement to bring Catholic thought and culture to the secular academy, nowhere more important than here at Harvard. ■

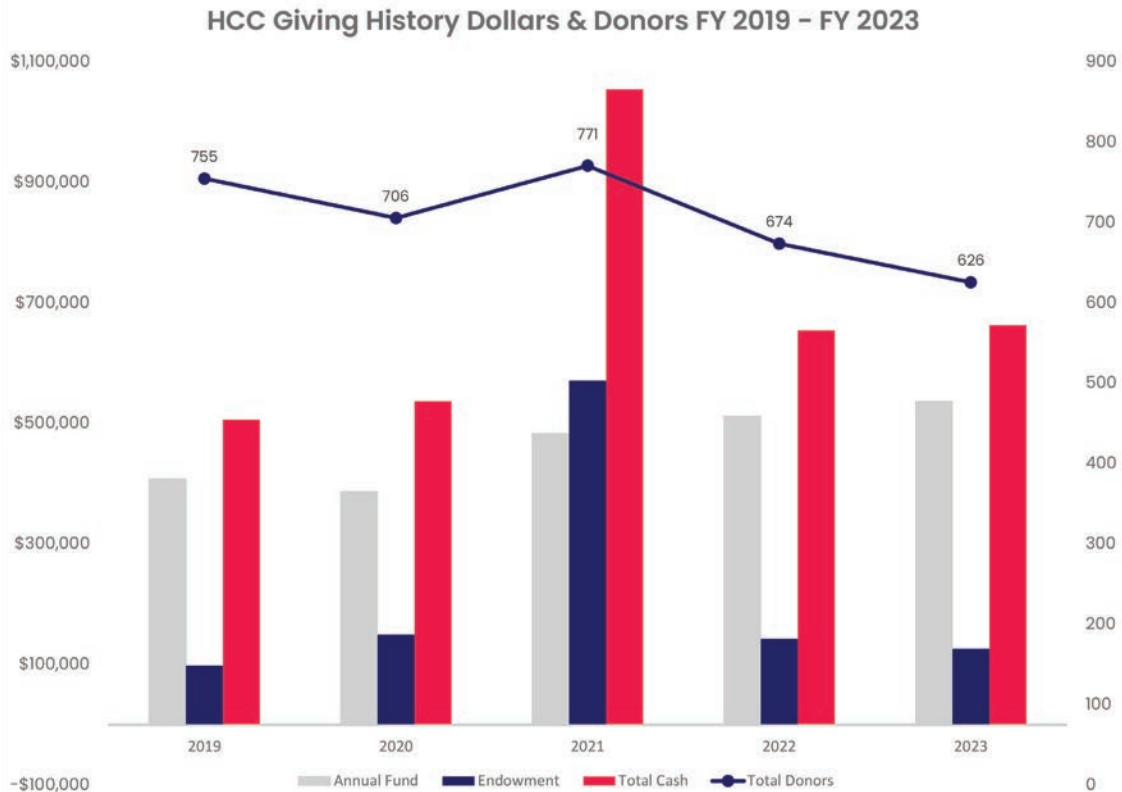

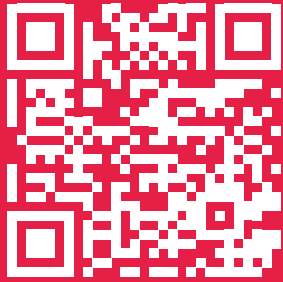
