St. Paul's Parish in Harvard Square is now completing its 150th Anniversary year (1875–2025), punctuated by beautiful celebratory liturgies, lectures, concerts, and service projects. For over 130 years, part of the parish's mission has been to serve as a special home to the Catholics of Harvard, specifically through the Harvard Catholic Club, now the Harvard Catholic Center.

I know you would share my excitement to see the vitality of the Harvard Catholic community which passes by my office each day. First years mingling with seniors, Catholic professors chatting with students after Mass outside the church daily, and a constant flow to confession, Eucharistic Adoration, and social outreach opportunities. (One image captures the joy of being here: 35 Harvard Varsity athletes crammed into one of the Center's larger rooms each Wednesday night for Bible study and fraternity.)

I am also happy to report that we have over 70 people in our parish OCIA program (formerly RCIA), preparing adults for full entrance into the Catholic church. Almost three quarters of those participants are Harvard students.

STUDENT REFLECTION

Over the past five years, the image of Harvard from national headlines is a school in crisis. From the pandemic to protests, leadership changes to funding fights, Harvard indeed has faced turbulence and dark moments.

In the midst of this confusion and darkness, though, I have noticed another storyline at Harvard not getting the national attention. I noticed it in a Catholic Center Bible study, where Protestant, Muslim, and even atheist students came to ask questions. I noticed it after an Economics section, where several students swarmed the Catholic teaching fellow and asked him questions, not about the impersonal and invisible hand of the market, but about the personal and visible work of the Church in society. I noticed it in House dining halls, where sports teams from football to lacrosse to hockey met weekly to ask questions about the faith. Amidst Harvard's uncertainty and darkness, people are yearning for stable truths, real meaning, and authentic community. And although this escapes the notice of national media, it has not escaped the notice of the Catholic Center.

From its very beginning, the Harvard Catholic Center was founded to bring truth, meaning, and community not just to Catholics at Harvard, but to all of campus and to the whole world. When over one-hundred people gathered in Harvard Yard in 1893 to form the

Harvard Catholic Society, they made it explicit that they wanted to "benefit the university" and the "entire country" by their work promoting the faith.

Today, as Harvard students and the world search for truth, meaning, and community more than ever, I have seen the Catholic Center live up to its commitment to be a light in the dark-

ness. I've seen it in the hundreds of students learning Catholic fellowship by sharing dinner together after Mass each week. I've seen it in the 200 students sacrificing one hour each week of studying Biochemistry and Econometrics to study the Word of God. I've seen it in the students being invited and coming back to Mass for the first time in years, students who have received the gift of Our Lord's mercy in the Sacrament of Confession for the first time in four years, students who have learned how to properly pray for the first time in their lives. Most visibly, I've seen it every year at the Easter Vigil at St. Paul's, in the more than forty people entering the Church, with more than a dozen of them from Harvard.

Just as the light from the Baptismal Candle creates a spark that illuminates the entire church at the Easter Vigil, so too have I seen the Catholic Center provide that same spark of light to Harvard and to the world.

To be at Harvard in 2025 is, in many ways, to be immersed in the brokenness and darkness and hunger of the world. But to be at the Harvard Catholic Center in 2025 is to be the light that cannot be hidden, the shining city on the hill—so that Harvard and all the world may see the goodness of Our Lord and give Him glory. ■

## CHAPLAIN REFLECTION

### *Rev. Nathaniel Sanders, Undergraduate Chaplain*

**N**ow that I have been at the Harvard Catholic Center for 18 months, please allow me to share something of my experience. When I first arrived, the devotion and commitment of the students was the most striking aspect. I had naively assumed that Catholic life in Harvard Square might have been moribund. I was wrong. After a year-and-one-half, I can confidently state that I was very wrong.

Christ is at work among the student body here. We are blessed to see the effects in numerous ways. With over 75 people in OCIA/adult Confirmation (from both the Catholic Center and the Parish), a student Mass attendance frequently over 300

people, hundreds in bible studies, and the numerous service hours given, it is clear that we are on the cusp of something great. As Archbishop Henning said during St. Paul's 150th anniversary Mass, it seems that a revival is happening among the young. This is especially true here at Harvard.

Serving as a priest and a chaplain at this moment in the Harvard Catholic Center is a privilege. I get to witness the wonderful ways the students grow in their faith. Part of this role is planning for the future of the Catholic Center, to ensure that this growth continues.

# HARVARD CATHOLIC FORUM

*Celebrating 5 Years*





The 2024-25 academic year marked the Harvard Catholic Forum's fifth year! Our growing audiences testify to a widespread hunger for the fullness of Beauty, Truth, and Goodness, here at Harvard and beyond.

It's a cultural inflection point: you can feel a new and more widespread "pull" to the transcendent, an upsurge of young people drawn to a serious engagement with the faith. Our mission: lean into that surge with timeless Catholic wisdom.

Some highlights of the Forum's 38 programs this year,

- Our public lectures and panels, non-credit courses, and reading groups engage the amazing breadth and depth of the Catholic intellectual and cultural tradition, adding a unique strength to the Harvard Catholic Center's ministry by showcasing an intellectually rigorous faith that thrives in the university.
- We offer large open forums that attract inquirers, and intensive small-group learning for those who want to dive deeper, with text study, conversation, training in sacred music and languages.
- We invite our participants into a Catholic intellectual community with receptions and meals that spark informal conversation and friendship.

- A major series "Outreach through the Arts," generously funded by the Considine Family Foundation, gave us a special opportunity to "lead with beauty" this year, through the visual arts, music, literature, and film: Elizabeth Lev on Caravaggio, Joseph Connors on the sacred in baroque Rome, the Forum's own student schola with the Cornell Chant Choir in concert, a half-day workshop on Handel's *Messiah*, a full-year course on Dante's *Divine Comedy*, three movie screenings with discussion, fiction reading groups— and more.

- Our community of 15 Student Fellows grew in leadership and mission by offering eight reading groups or workshops, including Catholic Social Thought and Choral Singing, while deepening their Catholic identity through friendship and common exploration in meals among themselves or with distinguished speakers.

The numbers show our cumulative impact over five years. Through June 2025,

- 4,700 total in-person audience at lectures, talks, and sacred music programs;
- 1000 participation in semester courses, seminars, and reading groups;
- 5,200 total livestream audience, including many Harvard alumni and friends from around the world;

- Over 72,000 views on archived programs.

During the year we continued to broaden our bases of institutional support, with a significant grant to fund Catholic Virtue Education from a private foundation, and a new round of funding from the John Templeton Foundation (Grant #63614, through the Lumen Christi Institute), both aiming to leverage matching funds from our Annual Fund contributors.

With thanks to our many donors and in gratitude for the many gifts of the Holy Spirit, our critical mission of bringing Catholic wisdom to Harvard continues to grow. ■

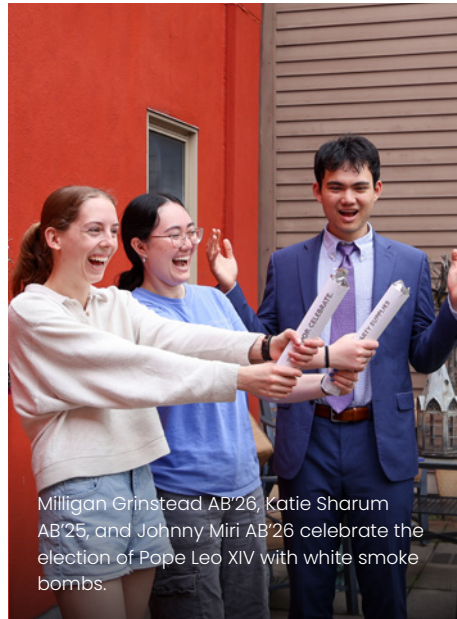

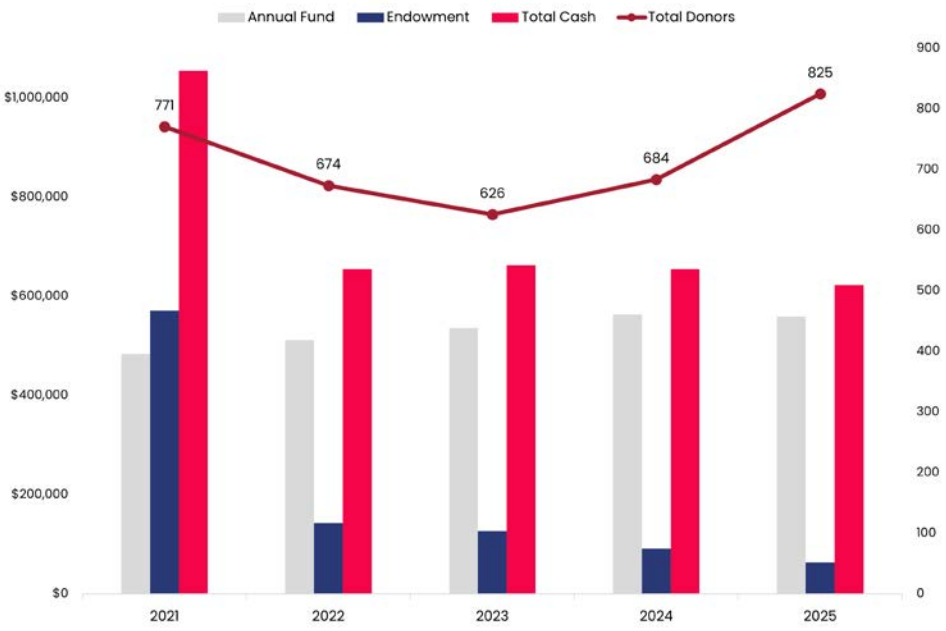
